ADAM SCOTT, STUART APPLEBY AND LUKE DONALD COMMIT

Top-10 PGA TOUR Money List and FedEx Cup Point Members Mark Calcavecchia, John Rollins and Boo Weekley Strengthen Tournament Field

Dublin, Ohio – April 25, 2007 – Tournament officials announced today that Stuart Appleby and Luke Donald will join World No. 3 Adam Scott as members of the 2007 Memorial Tournament field.

On strength of two top-10s in six events in 2007 and his fourth career victory at the season-ending TOUR Championship in 2006 **Scott** ranks No. 3 in the Official World Golf Ranking and No. 8 in FedEx Cup points. With more than \$1.7 million in earnings, he is ranked No. 9 on the PGA TOUR and World Money lists. Scott has been a member of two Presidents Cup teams (2003, 2005) and will be making his fourth appearance in the Memorial Tournament, which is scheduled for May 28-June 3. Among Scott's career-best 10 top-10 finishes in 2006 was a tie for fourth at Muirfield Village Golf Club.

Appleby enjoyed a multi-win (2) 2006 season and finished the year eighth on the money list with \$3,470,457, both career-highs in his 11 years on the Tour. He has recorded two top-10 finishes so far in 2007 and ranks No. 18 in the world rankings and No. 29 in FedEx Cup points. Appleby is ranked No. 23 on the World Money List with more than \$1.08 million in earnings and has been a member of four Presidents Cup teams (1998, 2000, 2003, 2005).

Coming off a career 2006 season with 16 cuts made in 18 starts, **Donald** posted a career-best 10 top-10s with earnings topping \$3 million. The two-time Ryder Cup team member (2004, 2006) has recorded two PGA TOUR and two international victories in his career. With four top-10s in 2007, Donald currently ranks No. 11 in the world rankings and No. 19 in FedEx Cup points. He ranks No. 18 and No. 20, respectively, on the PGA TOUR and World Money lists with more than \$1.1 million. Donald will be making his fourth appearance at this year's Memorial and his first since missing the cut in 2004.

Others who have committed to joining Scott, Appleby and Donald as part of the 2007 Memorial Tournament field are: Mark Calcavecchia, John Rollins, and Boo Weekley, each currently ranked in the top10 in FedEx Cup points and on the PGA TOUR money list.

Calcavecchia, the 1989 British Open champion, ranks No. 5 in FedEx Cup points and No. 8 on the PGA TOUR money list. His four top-10 finishes in 2007 includes his 13th career PGA TOUR victory at the PODS Championship. He currently ranks No.1 in *Total Birdies* on TOUR (163) and No. 3 in *Total Driving*. Calcavecchia has been a member of four Ryder Cup teams (1987, 1989, 1991, 2002) and one Presidents Cup team (1998). **Rollins** has finished in the top-10 on three occasions this season, including two runner-up finishes. He presently ranks No. 6 in FedEx Cup points and on the PGA TOUR money list with more than \$1.8 million in earnings. **Weekley** will be making his Memorial Tournament debut. On strength of three top-10s, including his first-career PGA TOUR victory at the Verizon Heritage, Weekley currently ranks No. 9 in FedEx Cup points and No. 10 on the PGA TOUR money list.

All-Tournament Patron Badges to the 2007 Memorial Tournament are available to the general public. The badges, valid Monday, May 28 through Sunday, June 3, are available for \$155 until April 30. The public may call the Tournament ticket office weekdays at 877-MT BADGE between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. to purchase badges or purchase them on-line at www.thememorialtournament.com. Daily tickets for Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday practice rounds are also available. The cost is \$30, and they are valid for all three practice round days.
