AUTOGRAPH POLICY

For the safety of the players and gallery members alike, a NO AUTOGRAPH POLICY is enforced on the golf course during the week of the Memorial Tournament including practice rounds. In consideration of the players, spectators are asked to refrain from requesting autographs during competition and must wait until after a player has completed his round.

BADGES

Badges are to be displayed in plain sight at all times. The Tournament is not responsible for lost badges.

CHAIR POLICY

- When opened, seat of chair cannot sit higher than 18 inches off the ground.
- Chairs cannot be wider than 20 inches.
- Chair backs cannot extend more than 14 inches from the seat.
- Chairs in bags are prohibited. For security, the bags will be prohibited from the Tournament grounds.

We have set this policy with your safety in mind, which is a high priority for us. At golf tournaments there is always the possibility of an errant shot reaching the gallery areas. If a golf ball is heading toward you and you are seated in a chair with arms, your ability to move quickly to avoid being struck is severely inhibited.

Consideration was also given to the other spectators around you when this policy was set. Their safety as well as their ability to view the Tournament in an unimpeded manner is very important to us.

You may want to consider bringing a seat cushion, similar to those used in stadiums. We will be offering a collapsible chair this year in our outdoor pro shops, as well as seat cushions, for your convenience.

CONCEALED WEAPON LAW

It is illegal to carry a firearm, deadly weapon, or dangerous ordnance anywhere on the grounds at Muirfield Village Golf Club, unless otherwise authorized by law. No person shall knowingly possess, have under the person's control, convey, or attempt to convey a deadly weapon or dangerous ordnance onto Tournament grounds.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

No food or beverage is permitted upon admittance. No beverage containers of any type are allowed to be brought onto or taken off the golf course, including water bottles.

GOLD ETIQUETTE AND ATTIRE

- Stay quiet and stand still when the players are about to hit the ball.
- "Hands in the air" means stop and be quiet while golfers are playing their shots.
- Stay behind the ropes at all times.
- Help patrons be considerate of each other and kneel or sit down whenever possible, to allow better viewing for those behind you.
- For your own safety, follow the directions of the tournament marshals.

Spectators will be removed immediately without warning for:

- * Refusal to obey quiet signs or signals.
- * Distracting or embarrassing a player.
- * Making rude, vulgar, or other inappropriate comments or gestures toward a player.
- * Booing or cheering at inappropriate times.

Suggested Golf Attire

Appropriate casual golf wear with comfortable walking shoes (soft spikes only).

Spectators should have the following items on hand:

Wind breaker

Hat/visor

Sunscreen

Sunglasses

Umbrella

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Observe the leaderboards throughout the golf course for "WEATHER WARNING" signs that will appear prior to inclement weather moving into the area. When the signs appear spectators are advised to take precautions PRIOR to play being suspended. If the siren sounds, seek shelter immediately.

IN THE EVENT OF INCLEMENT WEATHER, AVOID THE FOLLOWING:

Open areas • Hilltops/high places • Isolated trees • Golf Carts • Wire Fences

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Cameras

Still cameras are only permitted on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of Tournament week and are NOT allowed Thursday through Sunday. Video equipment is prohibited all seven days.

The following items are prohibited on the course ALL week. Please leave them in your car or check them at the gate:

Cellular Phones

TVs and Radio

Folding Armchairs

Canvas Chair Bags

Camera/binocular Cases

Backpacks/Large Purses

Periscopes

Coolers

Signs

Beepers

Weapons

Ladders

Pets/Animals

Picnic Baskets

Segways

Please Note: Strollers are permitted on the course.

Prohibited bags of any kind cannot be left at security checkpoints and will be required to be returned to your vehicle. For Security purposes, you hereby consent to the reasonable inspection/search of your person, property and vehicle before entering the Tournament.
